3. Update on the 2015 IATBR conference

- **Location:** The *Beaumont Estate* in Windsor has 440 bedrooms (200 bedrooms minimum commitment).
- **Congress organization:** Planned 6 parallel sessions. It will probably starts on Monday, before lunch and finishe on Thursday evening, with the social dinner on Thursday night. Possible cost 500 Pounds for early registration and hotel. Early registration due 31 May.
- **Status of the submissions:** 396 abstracts received (96% complete reviews. 216 papers will be accommodated. Full paper due 30 April.
- **Publications:** Planned 4 special issues on *Transportation Research Part A*, *Transportation Research Part B*, *Transportation* and *Journal of Choice Modelling*. Other suggestions are: *Travel Behaviour and Society* and *Journal of Land use Modelling*, plus a book.
